Improving energy efficiency, saving money and helping Nevadans



Working in partnership with Nevada Housing Division, Nevada Rural Housing Authority's Weatherization Assistance Program helps reduce the cost of utilities and improve energy conservation for low-income Nevadans. Assistance is provided free of charge for those living in single-family homes, multi-family units and mobile homes.

The Weatherization Program is funded by the US Department of Energy and the Fund for Energy Assistance Conservation.

Services

Following is a list of typical services provided through Nevada Rural Housing Authority Weatherization Assistance:

- **Ceiling, floor and duct insulation**
- **Duct leakage sealing**
- **Window replacement**
- **Water heater and water pipe insulation**
- **Furnace replacement**
- **Refrigerator replacement**
- **Installation of low flow shower head**
- **Carbon monoxide alarm installation**
- **Attic insulation**

Income limits

In order to receive free Weatherization Assistance, you will need to apply for assistance and meet certain criteria. To get started:
